Purpose

This qualification is for people seeking to perform the functions of a Mate on commercial coastal vessels.

The qualification recognises that the holder has the required skills in marine engineering, navigation and seamanship and sea survival and sea safety, and in addition has skills in first aid.

The qualification has a significant degree of commonality with the National Certificate in Maritime (Commercial In-shore Vessel Operations) with an optional strand in Business Operations and holders may progress towards holding both qualifications.

Special Notes

The Certificate of Competency (Licence to Operate) is issued in addition to this qualification following fulfilment of Maritime New Zealand (MNZ) requirements.

Employers who recruit trainees must ensure that the trainees are supplied with the relevant information and procedures relating to MNZ requirements.
